MINUTES OF JUNE 8, 2010

CALL TO ORDER

The June 2010 meeting of the Chevelon Butte School Board was called to order by President Cliff Schweigert at 5:00 P.M. The pledge was said by all present. Members present in Forest Lakes were Cliff Schweigert, Cheryl Rife and Deborah Morris. Members present in Blue Ridge were Jean Gilbertson and Linda Blosser. Virgi Scholl, Mary St. Germain, Eric Hedlund, and Jan Walls were present in Forest Lakes. Kelsey Gilbertson, Liz Tucker and Lou Hoover were present in Blue Ridge.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes of the regular May meeting were presented. Cliff moved to approve the minutes as presented. Linda seconded. Passed. Payroll voucher 23 and 24 and vouchers 1045, 1046, and 1047 were presented for approval. Cliff moved to approve as presented. Deborah seconded. Passed

CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Eric Hedlund volunteered to fix the cooler pipes. Cliff thought that was a nice offer and would talk to him about it. Lou Hoover talked about the posting of agendas in Blue Ridge. He feels the bulletin board needs enlarging. The Board will put this on the next regular meeting's agenda.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Cliff reported he had met with Winslow's Superintendent and their offer for an IGA was double the current tuition plus all costs of special needs students. He presented his needs as set tuition, assurance of acceptance of all students and Chevelon Butte provides transportation. Cliff was also in touch with Pine/Strawberry School District. They have room for our students and they welcome tuition students. Cliff was also in contact with Payson School District and they also welcomed tuition students. Jean Gilbertson does not favor going anywhere but Winslow as they offer Navitt courses as well and the other districts do not. She realizes that as open enrollment students no transportation is possible without raising taxes. Linda felt the Winslow starting offer was too expensive for us. It was agreed that more talks were needed. Cliff moved to table this item until the Board had more information. Jean seconded. Passed.
2. The status of the building replacement has not changed a great deal. Cliff has had phone conversations with Matt Ryan and Steve Peru. Mr. Peru is doing research on monies available, impact on conditional use permit, whether it will require a new septic system, if the sheriff has space what their contribution would be and the advantages of site built vs. modular. The work session with all parties involved is on hold until this research has been done. Mr. Ryan did say that there

would have to be an IGA that would specify what would happen to the property and building should the school district dissolve and how costs would be shared. Linda moved to table this item until a future meeting. Cliff seconded. Passed

NEW BUSINESS

1. Mary explained why she felt a need for unified forms for the district. She presented student information forms and bus conduct forms. Cliff moved to accept the forms as presented. Jean seconded. Passed.
2. Payment of lunch for the Thursday budget work session was presented. It would be paid from Civic Fund money ...no tax money. Cliff moved to approve payment of lunch. Cheryl seconded. Passed.
