MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 15, 2012

CALL TO ORDER

President Linda Blosser called the regular meeting of the Chevelon Butte Governing Board to order at 5:00 P.M. The pledge was said by all present. Present in Forest Lakes was Cheryl Rife and Trina Cooper. Present in Blue Ridge were President Linda Blosser, Richard Eng and Don Peterson. Richard moved to adopt the agenda as presented. Don seconded. Passed.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of January 10, 2012 were presented. Linda moved to accept the minutes. Don seconded. Passed.

RATIFICATION OF VOUCHERS

Expense vouchers 1224, 1225 and 1226 were presented. Payroll vouchers 14 and 15 were presented. Linda moved to accept the vouchers as presented. Don seconded. Passed.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

1. Linda explained that Mr. Kelty had given her a copy of HB 2411 concerning drug testing of elected officials and would like feedback from Board members. Don stated his opposition to it. Linda said they were elected volunteers. She also wondered who results would be reported to. Richard said regular meds could be made into an issue. He also voiced concerns, but stated that the Legislature itself would be bound by this bill, so he didn't expect it to pass.
2. Linda stated that HB 2075 was included for informational purposes.
3. The letter from Mr. Huppenthal was also for informational purposes also.
4. Linda announced that Denese Bomar has completed her training to become a bus driver and that she now has her certificate.

LEAD BUS DRIVER'S REPORT

Larry Sears was not present. Linda read his report. This report included information on all buses...repairs, windshield replacements, etc. All buses are up and running now. Norell has been gone and everyone else stepped up to fill in. There are no student disciplinary problems at this time.
