MINUTES OF MARCH 13, 2012

CALL TO ORDER

President Linda Blosser called the regular meeting of the Chevelon Butte Governing Board to order at 5:00 P.M. The pledge was said by all present. Present in Forest Lakes was Linda Blosser, Cheryl Rife and Trina Cooper. Present in Blue Ridge were Richard Eng and Don Peterson. Richard moved to adopt the agenda as presented. Cheryl seconded. Passed.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of February 15, 2012 were presented. Don moved to accept the minutes. Trina seconded. Passed.

RATIFICATION OF VOUCHERS

Expense vouchers 1227, 1228, 1229 and 1230 were presented. Payroll vouchers 16 and 17 were presented. Linda moved to accept the vouchers as presented. Trina seconded. Passed.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

1. Linda reported that the FEMA paperwork has been completed and that it is being audited now.
2. Linda reported that the budget process for next year has started. She also reported that there will be a budget revision necessary in May.
3. She reported that we have applied for an ADE Small School Transportation Adjustment.
4. The parking issue in Blue Ridge has been resolved with all papers being signed. Buses should be able to park at the new area by the beginning of the next school year.
5. Linda reported that the AHERA survey and report was being done on the District Office on Wednesday. When it is finalized we will be in total compliance with both the AZ state statues and Federal statues.

LEAD BUS DRIVER'S REPORT

Larry Sears was not present.

CALL TO THE PUBLIC

There was no public present in Blue Ridge. Linda read the Call to the Public statement to the public present in Forest Lakes. William Morris spoke to the Board and requested that the Board consider having the students from Forest Lakes go the Payson Unified School District next year instead of Heber/Overgaard Unified School District. Linda said the issue would be brought up later on the agenda and if it was okay with everyone the Board could discuss it in detail then...everyone agreed.

OLD BUSINESS

1. Linda asked the Board if there were any additions/changes they wanted on the forms. Richard asked who had put the forms together. Linda told him that it was a collaboration between Larry Sears and herself. All Board members agreed that it was well done and no changes were needed at this time.
2. The Driver/Aide evaluation forms were presented. All Board members agreed that they looked good. Don pointed out that the Board approved a need for the evaluation form at an earlier meeting. Mary was directed to find the date of that meeting. If necessary, this item will be put on a future agenda for formal approval.

NEW BUSINESS

1. After a very brief discussion, Linda moved and Cheryl seconded to put the policy advisories on next month's agenda. Passed.
2. Linda explained why the issue of having one permanent bus stop was on the agenda. She also explained that the Church in Blue Ridge was willing to have it on their property since the buses would be parked there. Don stated the issue was moot since we now have an agreement with the Blue Ridge Community Church. No further action was taken.
3. Linda asked Mr. Morris to explain why he wants to move the Forest Lakes students to Payson. He explained that he felt the students would have more opportunity to get a better academic education. He also stated that he had only talked to a couple of other parents about this. Linda explained that this would take quite a bit of further research. She asked if Mr. Morris would be willing to talk to all of the parents. He agreed to do so and will report his discussions at the next Board Meeting. Mr. Cooper asked who would transport the students. Liberty Morehead, our current bus driver, said she would be willing to do so. Linda asked that parents put a list of concerns in writing and get them to Mary for Board distribution. Mary advised to put this issue on next month's agenda for further discussion.

ADJOURNMENT

Don moved to adjourn the meeting. Trina seconded. Passed. The meeting was adjourned at 5:28 PM.
